

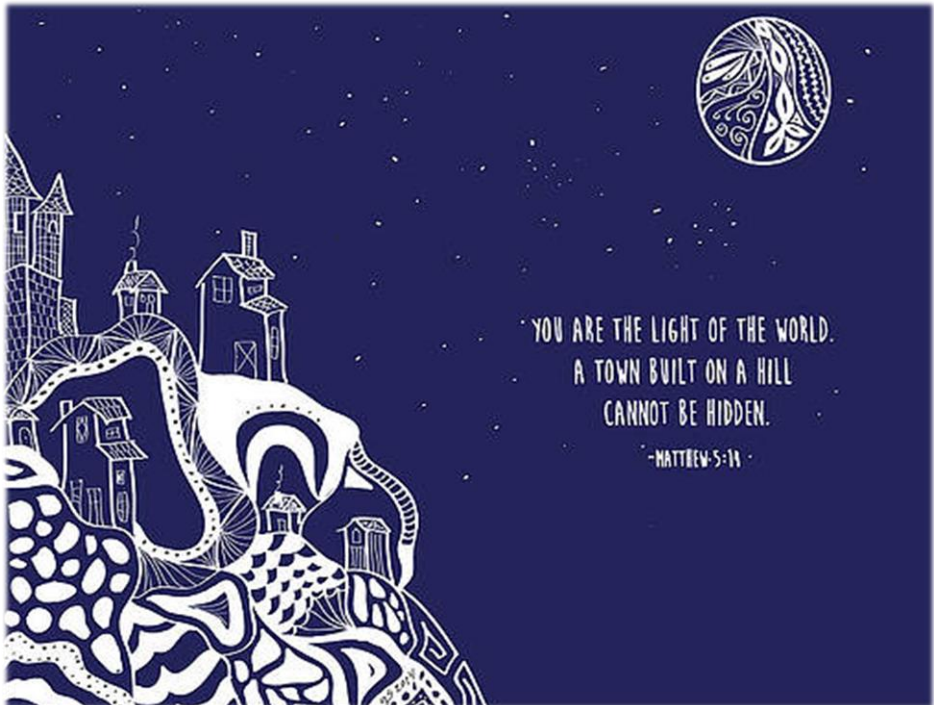

Our Lent this year will follow the Lectionary. The Old Testament readings help us remember key acts of God in history: from Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden, the calling of Abraham, the people of Israel in the desert, David's anointing as king, to the prophecies of Ezekiel and in Holy Week to the Death and Resurrection of Jesus.

Wednesday Bible Studies 7:15-8:15 pm. Our Wednesday studies will focus on the Gospel for the week. They will be in the Hall, following choir practice.
